John XXIII Educational Center is a nonprofit in Racine whose mission is to empower the youth in Racine to become leaders through academic and social support. John XXIII offers students a supervised study hall, complete with mentoring and tutoring. It is a safe, welcoming environment for students to work at their own pace, while being motivated by staff and volunteers. Staff also plan enrichment time activities for students to build personal skills and to help students set goals for the future. The Middle School Program offers students a Thursday Theme Night activity during the last half hour of session to work on social skills such as teamwork, resiliency, problem solving, etc. These activities are also a good way for students to make new friends with their peers from other schools. Once in high school, students will hear from guest speakers from various professional careers to learn about their collegiate and workforce options after high school. Students are also invited to go on college tours with the High School Coordinator.

Registration is open throughout the school year to all middle and high school students regardless of race, religion or background. There is a recommended \$25.00 contribution per semester for instructional materials; there are other options for contribution upon request.
