BEYOND THE BOOKS

FAITH - Students begin their day with our student-led morning broadcast and end the day in prayer together. Students also lead weekly Mass, Holy Days, and other special occasions. Father visits classrooms weekly for a unique Faith conversation as well!

ACADEMIC SUPPORT - We have a full-time School Counselor and a full-time Learning Support Coordinator. In addition, we also have Educational Assistants in K4. K5, and middle school.

EXTRACURRICULARS - We provide multiple opportunities for our students to learn new skills and widen their interests. After-school clubs and enrichment programs include after-school academic support, athletics, STEM Club, and Boy/Girl Scouts. We also partner with the John 23rd Educational Center to support our students as well.

STEM EDUCATION

STEM at OLOGA includes studying all aspects of the science field. Project Lead the Way, available to all middle school students, has given the students an opportunity to explore computer programming, become medical detectives, and engineer various items, including drawing in two and three dimensions with attention to detail and measurements for their drawings. Legos are used in classrooms to increase students' knowledge of the engineering process. Students also have the opportunity to complete labs in our newly updated Science Lab on the following topics: Scientific Method, phases of the moon, dissections, water cycle, and many more.
